WHAT ABOUT THE HOSPITAL YOU ARE BUILDING?

The hospital at Livolo is the one and only hospital in the whole district. Several hundred thousand people have to walk, carrying their sick, no less than 40 km to get to the nearest hospital, and great many die on the way. Easily treated diseases remain untreated and people end up crippled, blind or permanently impaired if they live at all.

Cal Bombay began building this hospital when he was Vice-President of Missions at Crossroads, ending in December 2003. Since that time, the whole facility sits unfinished.

equipment now on hand becomes less than useful is essential.

Near to the hospital is one of the first, and very few, Teacher Training Schools in southern Sudan. A Skills Training School is also nearby teaching carpentry, cabinet making and brick-laying. Cal Bombay Ministries has given HASS a tractor with equipment to farm the rich local soil for food for both the schools and eventually, the hospital.

Upon completion the hospital will have a total of 112 manual, but modern beds. Each ward will have nurse's station, a reception/registration, medical store and washroom facilities (inside!)

It is the only project other than the mass farming project in which Cal Bombay Ministries is involved. You may want to get involved either financially, or in Christian Service in either of these endeavours.

Cal Bombay feels he has a moral obligation to try to finish what he started while at Crossroads.

It is being constructed by the

“Humanitarian Assistance For Southern Sudan” (HASS – an indigenous Christian Agency). Both HASS and the Government of Southern Sudan are eager to see it completed. But Cal needs help to help them now.

The hospital has four major 28 bed wards already built. A Centre block with operating rooms, administration, medical stores and offices needs to be built. Several doctors’ and nurses’ houses are almost complete.

Because of the hospital being built at Liwolo, and since the Peace Agreement was signed in January 2005 many people are moving into the area to settle. A small town is literally developing right next to the hospital compound. They want and need this very badly.

The hospital will be one of the most modern in all of southern Sudan, when it is finished. Some hospitals, such as in a very large city called

Yei have very poor facilities. A part of it was bombed and many died there.

Now that the North/South war is over, Liwolo is one of the safest places in Sudan to build a hospital.

It is almost there! There is a need for at least \$100,000.00 (US) to be able to get the hospital functional. There exists yet the need for electrical wiring, plumbing, the laying of terrazzo floors as well as wall tiles in rooms needing to be sterile.

Some good things **have** happened. A doctor and his wife sent \$10,000.00 (Canadian) which has been forwarded to try to finish one ward. A young challenged man has dedicated ALL his birthday gifts, and held a party, highlighting the hospital as designated, and raised \$8000.00 (Canadian) That is on it’s way as well.

Also several nurses from the USA are going to investigate the hospital as a probable destination for their living and working there.

Much of the equipment, such as beds and furniture, as well as an X-ray machine, operating table, incubators, medical instruments, dressings and bedding are already on site – sitting unused.
