WHY IS A CENTRAL ADMINISTRATIVE COMPOUND NECESSARY?

With at least fifty farms to be developed in the next ten years, it is essential that there be a Centre from which all administrative personnel operate. This will, by sheer necessity be the largest compound for the Savannah Farmers Cooperative (SFC).

The compound will be surrounded by a tall bamboo fence, with added thorn bushes on the outside to keep out unwanted animals etc. It will have housing

ministrative Compound, it will be a very busy place.

All SFC owned vehicles, including 4 wheel drive Land Cruisers, our Seven Ton Isuzu truck, all tractors and equipment in current use will be centred there. (We buy only used road vehicles, normally straight from Japan)

We hope to have our own fuel depot and get our fuel at discounted prices.

Each tractor has to be licensed in southern Sudan, and all similar legal matters will be dealt with out that office compound for all the SFC farms. When all fifty farms are in operation, it will probably be the agricultural reference point for all of southern Sudan.

We have a long, long way to go, and it is only with your help, and the comparatively LARGE size of the dollar in their economy which will make this happen. The sooner the better, since inflation will certainly be a fact or the future.

for the General Manager, the Accountant, and any full-time staff working within the central compound (such as mechanics, well-drilling personnel etc).

The General Manager will be in charge of the compound. There will be an office block. It will consist of about four rooms, two for office functions, one for records, and another for stationery and supplies.

There will be a minimum of two four-bed guest houses for volunteer farmers visiting from North America, official visitors from management, the board of directors, visiting politicians, and overseas visitors. These will be good, solid and secure buildings.

A communal dining room and fellowship 'tukul' (large round screened in building) will be in the centre of the compound. It will be used for guests to eat, have fellowship, hold training courses and for relaxation in the evenings. A separate kitchen will be nearby where food will be prepared for all guests. The best available cook will be engaged in this compound. It may even have satellite TV which can be seen during the evening hours of relaxation, and to keep in touch with world affairs.

Since soil differs from farm to farm and from area to area in this very fertile south-western part of Sudan, a primary laboratory for soil testing will be located here. It will eventually develop into a more refined soil analysis centre, both for the SFC and

for small farmers throughout the area.

Large storage buildings (warehousing) will be built on this compound. We will relocate many of the containers from the various places they have gone to in Sudan, and use them to build at least a two storey high warehouse with a grass-sheltered or tin roof to avoid over-heating.

Similarly, a central workshop will be located here large enough to house our largest machinery for repair and maintenance. It too will be built of empty containers. A larger power generator is needed for this facility to run both power tools and electric lighting for the compound.

The yard will be large enough to contain sheds and shelters for the tractors and equipment owned by the SFC to be stored while awaiting repair, or those not on assignment. All machinery will be assigned to various farms and fields, from this compound, by the General Manager in consultation with the Managing Director.

The compound eventually will have semi-modern toilet and shower facilities. Local people can be hired for laundry, grounds-keeping and general labour purposes. All facilities will be lockable, and there will be armed gate-keepers on duty day and night.
